2. Luke 4:14 | Mark 6:1-6 | Matthew 13:54
  - a. Familiarity: forgetting that Jesus is King of kings and Lord of lords Isaiah 9:6
  - b. Offense: They were offended at him.
  - c. Unbelief limited Jesus's ability to minister to people.
  - d. I never want it to be said in this place, Jesus could not do any mighty miracles because of their unbelief.
3. Luke 7:18-23 John the Baptist
  - a. Doubt due to offense
  - b. When we suffer for Christ's sake
4. Mark 16:9-13 women testify of His Resurrection
  - a. Didn't believe the testimonies grief paralyzes us
  - b. When our knowledge overrides our faith
  - c. They had a hard heart
5. Matthew 14:28-33 Peter walks on water
  - a. We can start in faith in the word.
  - b. Then circumstances cause us to doubt
  - c. Help
6. Hebrews 3:12-4:3 failure to enter the promised land
  - a. Failure to hear
  - b. Deceitfulness of sin.
  - c. Hard heart
  - d. Not knowing the ways of God
  - e. Not mixing faith with the word -- egg and sperm have potential, but not life, only together is life sparked in a nanosecond if time.
